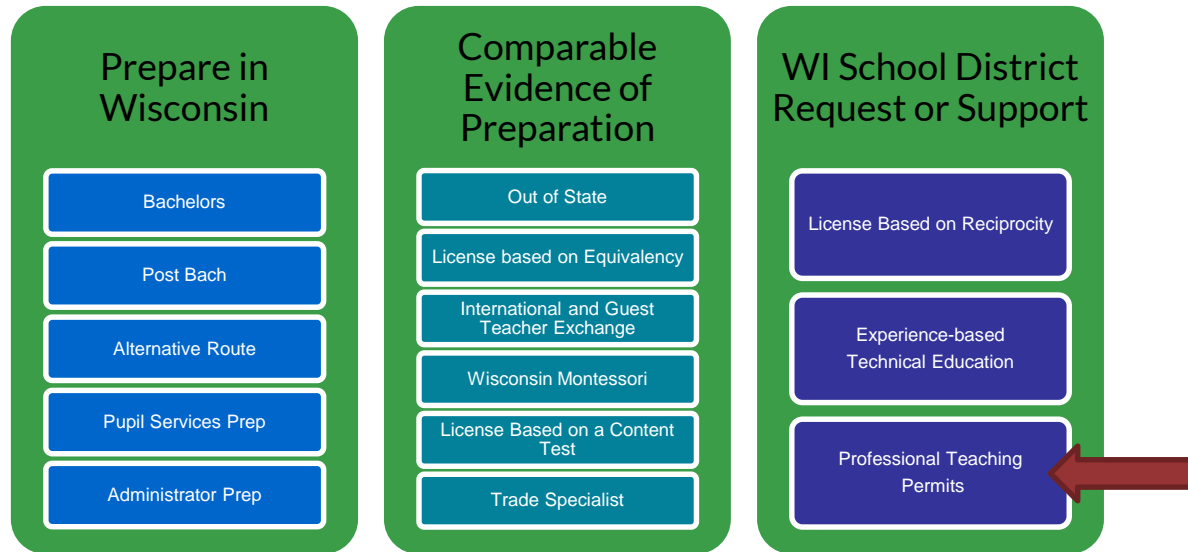

Professional Teaching Permit Pathway

•Candidate Profile

–Professional with a Bachelors degree in: Engineering, Math, Science, Computer Science, Art, Music, or World Languages. §118.192

Engineer can get a math permit, science permit, or technology education permit

–5 years of experience as a professional in the subject area in which the bachelor's degree was awarded

–Seeking a permit to teach in one of these shortage areas

•Candidate Profile

Provide Evidence of:

- ✓ A content test and
- ✓ A minimum of 100 hours of formal instruction in the application of modern curricula

Professional Teaching Permit Pathway

- **School District**

- Identifies shortage
- Cannot displace a qualified educator
